Beginning in the early 70's Kalyn Siebert began producing Oilfield, Drop Deck, Low Boy and specialized Heavy Haul trailers for the Construction, Agriculture and Energy markets. Since 1982, Kalyn Siebert has had some form of a contract with the U.S. Military to build various Military trailers for homeland and export use. Kalyn Siebert was purchased by Heil Trailer International in 2000 and Heil Trailer International/Kalyn Siebert is currently owned by American Industrial Partners (AIP).
